Port Adelaide FC Season 2017 Thank You – Cinematographer – Through Client *Anomaly* (2017)

Following the 2017 season Port Adelaide's major sponsor Renault wanted to make a thank you video for the fans for their support over the season. I was contracted by Anomaly to shoot groups of fans singing the club song along with star player Chad Wingard. I worked with Chad and the fans to create an engaging video that hit the brief for the client.

Foxtel Coaches Masterclass – Cinematographer (2017)

During the 2017 season Foxtel ran a competition for people to nominate their grassroots coaches to receive a masterclass from professional AFL coaches. The Adelaide winners were taken to AAMI Stadium for a masterclass with Crows coaches David Teague and Don Pyke where they were taken through methods and methodologies used at the AFL level of the game. I was tasked with capturing these grassroots coaches and showing the interaction between professional and local coaches, highlighting the importance of these grassroots coaches for the development of the game.

South Australian Tourism Champions – Cinematographer - Online Corporate (2015-2017)

Working with Flinders Creations and the South Australian Tourism Commission to create a range of corporate videos showcasing successful tourism operators across South Australia. Over the course of 12 months we travelled from Kangaroo Island to the Flinders Ranges and everywhere in between to interview each operator and highlight their success. I was the cinematographer on this project responsible for capturing the video and sound of each interview and creating beautiful imagery of South Australia and the people who make each business such a success.
